Images underscore issues of concern to people in these locales, while emphasizing the importance of collaborative efforts to safeguard the world's cultural heritage.

Carried out through scientific excellence and community involvement, these efforts focus on conservation and responsible growth at key World Heritage Sites. Projects are selected using strict criteria and each initiative follows a comprehensive methodology termed *Preservation by Design*®. This approach integrates master planning, scientific conservation, community engagement, and local partnerships. The organization currently has twelve projects in ten countries.
