Chavín Ceramics & Handicraft Program

Since 2008, GHF and Asociación Ancash have been funding the Chavín Ceramics & Handicraft Program, which connects local communities with their heritage, all the while creating jobs and new revenues for participants. The program has helped train communities in traditional arts and plans to facilitate the construction of a new ceramics workshop and display area in Chavín.



The Future of Chavín de Huántar

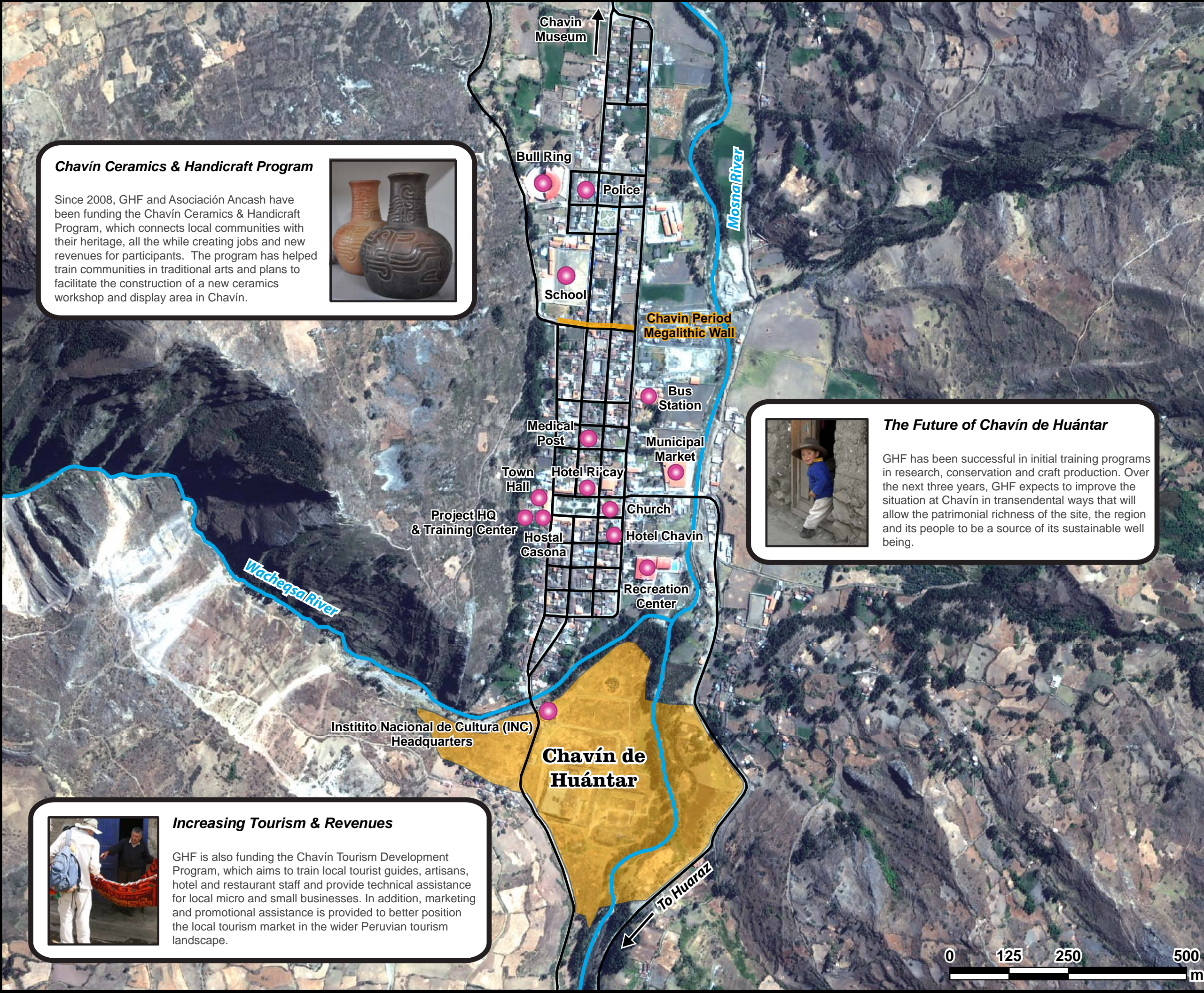

Increasing Tourism & Revenues



GHF is also funding the Chavín Tourism Development Program, which aims to train local tourist guides, artisans, hotel and restaurant staff and provide technical assistance for local micro and small businesses. In addition, marketing and promotional assistance is provided to better position the local tourism market in the wider Peruvian tourism landscape.
